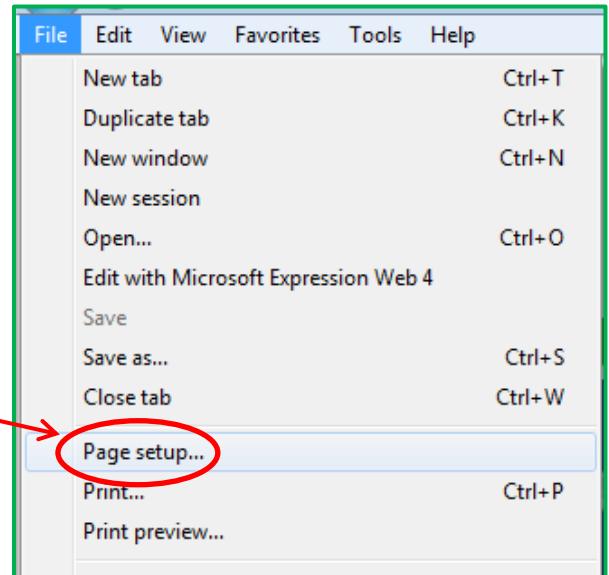



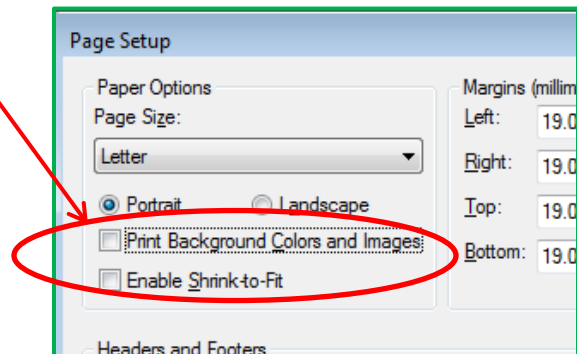
## Want to print the complete schedule or standings? Here is how to optimize the print-out using common web browsers:

### Internet Explorer

- Unhide the Menu Bar by right-clicking above the top page tabs and ensure “Menu bar” is checked (you can hide it again later by using the same steps, only unchecking the item)
- Click on “File” and in the dropdown menu click on “Page setup...”
- In the Page Setup window, ensure “Print Background Colors & Images” and “Enable Shrink-to-Fit” are unchecked and press “OK”




- Click on the  button at the top right corner of the frame (schedule page - white area)



- ***If you regularly print web pages, you'll probably want to re-enable the shrink-to-fit setting after you're done, or those web pages will likely get cropped off in print.***

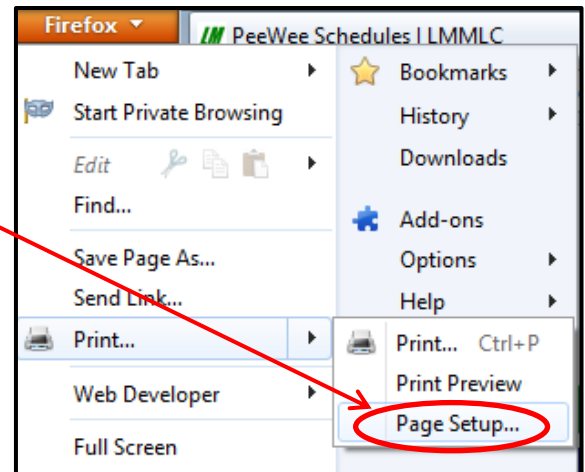
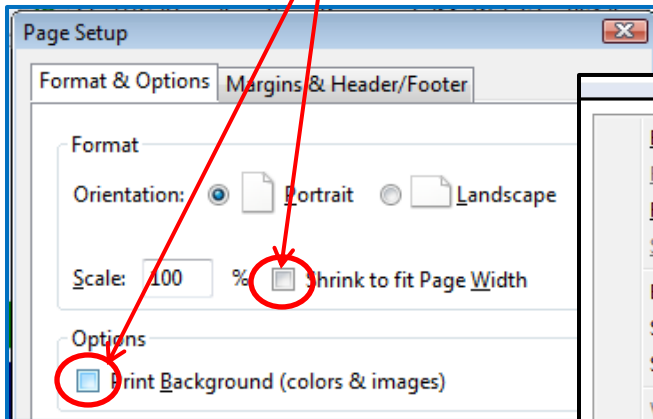

### Google Chrome

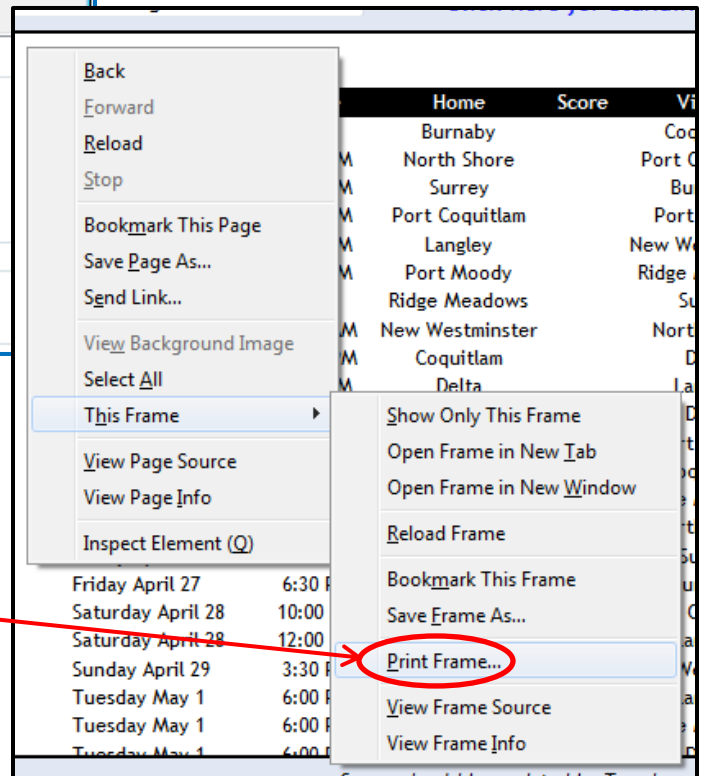
- Click on the  button at the top right corner of the frame (schedule page - white area)
  - There are no “shrink-to-fit” options in Chrome, therefore there are no ways to increase font sizes when printing. The good news is that there is no need, as the print size is exactly what it should be!

## Mozilla Firefox

- Click on the orange Firefox Box (top left corner of screen), scroll over “Print” to open dropdown menu and click on “Page Setup...”
- In the Page Setup window, ensure “Shrink to fit Page Width” and “Print Background (colors & images)” are unchecked and press “OK”




- Right click anywhere on the schedule (white area) and in the pop-up menu scroll over “This Frame” to open the dropdown menu and click on “Print Frame...”

## Safari (Apple Brower)

- Click on the  button at the top right corner of the frame (schedule page - white area)
- There are no “shrink-to-fit” options, therefore there are no ways to increase font sizes when printing
